

Airport Helsinki, Finland

Helsinki-Vantaa Airport is the largest commercial airport in Finland. Built in 1951, the airport has been under renovation since 2019 to accommodate increased passenger numbers. In addition, the construction of another terminal was already started in 2009.



SCHREIBER was able to contribute its many years of experience to this major project in the various phases of planning as well as execution. Numerous feasibility studies and dimensioning were carried out. Due to the early involvement in the respective project phases, the planning times for the products were considerably reduced. The products could thus be delivered and installed on site in less than four weeks production time. Various VS-JS type joints with lengths of up to 65 meters were installed.
