

Last Dance for Wiesbaden

The Rhein Main Congress Center (rmcc), newly built in 2018 in Wiesbaden/Germany, was equipped by SCHREIBER in October 2020 with retrofitted vibration technology. Due to vibrations above the first floor the entire Congress Center was equipped with TMD (Tunded Mass Dampers). The tuned mass dampers reduced the vibrations to an absolute minimum.





Based on many years of experience of the engineers at SCHREIBER, it was possible to reduce the vibrations considerably and also to use the mass dampers as design elements.

The 19 mass dampers, which have a dead weight of up to 4.5 tons, were mounted on the first floor ceiling in such a way that every visitor can see the mass dampers at work.
