

## AC11-Railway 5 – Tarkwa, Ghana

We at SCHREIBER have also been able to contribute to the revitalization of the railroad network in the West African state of Ghana.

The "Ghana Railway Master Plan" envisages a new, expanded standard-gauge rail network with a length of around 4.000 km, which has been implemented in six phases since 2018. The basic structures were already built during the colonial era as a narrow-gauge rail network and are outdated.

For the new AC 11 Railway 5 at Tarkwa, SCHREIBER manufactured a total of 580 pot bearings. In a very tight schedule between dimensioning, production and delivery of the pot bearings, we at SCHREIBER were able to deliver punctually and reliably as usual. The delivery was made by airplane in order to bridge the 8.000 kilometer distance as quickly as possible.

Tarkwa itself is the capital of the Wassa West District in the Western Region and an important rail junction on the line from Takoradi to Kumasi. It is also known for its gold deposits.
